What to do:

- 1. Fill the plant pot or window box with plotting compost.
- 2. Lay some sand on top of the compost.
- 3. Sow some seeds in three rows. The seeds must be just below the level of the compost.
- 4. Put a sheet of black bin bag on the top. This will help the seeds to grow, as well as stopping sparrows from picking them up.
- 5. Ask a grown-up to help you to put the pot or window box outside in a sunny spot on a window sil, away from the wind. (If the window sil is very narrow, the pot may fall off.)
- 6. The radish plants will slowly begin to grow. (The small plants are called seedlings.) Then you can lift off the bin bag.
